Directions to Guildford

By Car

- If approaching from London (A3) or the M25 (Junction 10), remain on the A3 until you reach the exit signed to *Cathedral and University*. Do not take the exit signed to *Guildford*.
- If approaching from the A322 or A323 from Bagshot or Aldershot, at the A3 roundabout take the exit signed to Portsmouth, and then turn off the A3 at the first exit (signed to *Cathedral and University*).
- If entering Guildford from Horsham (A281) or Godalming (A3100), leave the gyratory system at the exit marked *Farnham* (A31). After approximately 200 yards, at the mini-roundabout, take first turning into Guildford Park Road and continue along Madrid Road to The Chase for a mile. At the roundabout take the third exit, into the University.

Contact the taxi company a few days before your arrival or departure with your airline and flight number information: they will pick you up at the airport or the hotel.

- **By Coach:**

The Woking Rail-Air Link runs every 30 minutes from Heathrow (all terminals) to Woking Station and back. Inside Heathrow, follow the signs to “Local Buses” or “Buses” (do **not** go to the central bus station). The schedule and the platform information for each terminal can be found on the next page. You can buy tickets (£8 single) from the National Express ticket counter in Terminals 1, 3 and 4 or on the coach when leaving from Terminal 2. The journey to Woking takes about 45 minutes. From Woking Station, take a train toward Portsmouth Harbour to Guildford Station which is the next stop. Alternatively, take a taxi from Woking Station directly to the hotel in Guildford (around £12-15).

- **By Taxi (£44 per car):**

- **By Train:**

Trains to Guildford Station run roughly every hour from the train station in the South Terminal. A single ticket costs around £9. The journey takes roughly 45 minutes. Train information can be found online at <http://www.nationalrail.co.uk/>

Guildford Station - Hotel

The fast track to Heathrow

Welcome to the South West Trains Railair coach service which will take you direct from your local station via Woking to any of the four air terminals at London Heathrow (and return).

Fast

Departures every 30 minutes throughout the majority of the day, seven days a week#. With a journey time of less than an hour, the Woking Railair is the most convenient link between Woking Station and Heathrow Airport.

25 and 26 December, no service.

Arriving at Woking

On arrival by train at Woking station, follow the Railair signs to the exit on platform 5. There is a lift service linking all platforms. The coach leaves from immediately outside the station. Railair Customer Service staff will be on hand to assist you if required.

Returning from Heathrow

Finding the Railair coach is simple. Just follow the yellow signs marked 'Railair Link' with a yellow coach symbol to the door of the Arrivals Hall.

Check-in times

Please check your airline ticket or contact your airline for advice on check-in times. As a general guide:

International flights

Minimum 3 hours prior to departure.

European flights

Minimum 2 hours prior to departure.

Domestic flights

Minimum 1 hour prior to departure.

Pick-up points

The pick-up points are located as follows:

Terminal 1

Check in at the Bus/Coach Ticket desk, ground floor Arrivals. Coach departs from bus stop 11.

Terminal 2

Outside Arrivals, bus stop 4.

Terminal 3

Check in at the Bus/Coach Ticket desk in Arrivals at coach station exit. Bus stop 6.

Terminal 4

Outside Arrivals, bus stop 8.
